RULES and REGULATIONS

- 1 The Judge's decision is final at all times.
- 2 Entries will be strictly limited. No entry fees will be refunded except if accompanied by a Veterinary Certificate or Doctor's Certificate.
- 3 The closing date for entries will be 19th May 2017 (Late entries £1.00 extra numbers permitting)
- 4 The organisers reserve the right to :-
 1. Refuse entries without reason.
 2. Cancel, amalgamate or divide classes depending on numbers.
 3. Change the distribution of prize money or rosettes due to insufficient entries.
 4. Order any person to leave the ground if, in the opinion of the organisers, such an individual is causing a disruption likely to affect the enjoyment of others.
- 5 No claim can be entertained for anything that may happen to competitors, onlookers, their servants, horses or ponies in connection with the show. It is a condition of entry that each entrant will indemnify the organisers against any accident or loss, however caused.
- 6 Objections must be made in writing direct to the secretary's tent accompanied by a deposit of £10 returnable only if the objection is upheld.
- 7 Riders MUST wear hard hats at all times.
- 8 All dogs shall be kept under strict control and on a lead.
- 9 Competitors must respect the boundaries of the show site, work horses only in the designated areas and proceed at walk only in the vicinity of the rings.
- 10 Please leave the horsebox parking area tidy taking all litter with you.
- 11 If you find your class clashes, please report to BOTH Judges who will make the necessary arrangements.
- 12 Two refusals or a fall off will result in elimination from the event.
- 13 Spurs are not to be used by riders under 18 years old and not at all in Events 9 & 10.

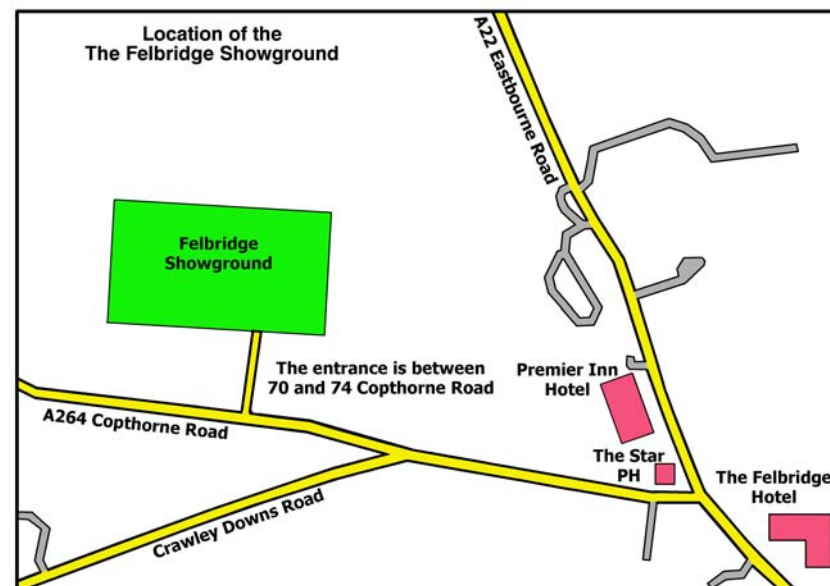

RING ONE.

Ella Popely Memorial Jumping in Bill Kear's Sand Arena.

Commencing 9:00 a.m. Sharp

Entry Fee - £8.00

Prizes: Trophy & Rosettes.

Class	Event
1	Novice Jumping – Horse Pony & Rider. Combination not to have won more than £15 total in jumping competitions. Starting height 2' 3".
2	Novice Jumping – Horse Pony & Rider. Combination not to have won more than £25 total in jumping competitions. Starting height 2' 6".
LUNCH	
3	Horley Lions Stakes -- Horses/Ponies of any height. Time closest to the bogey time set by the judge wins. Height 2' 6".
4	Local Jumping. Horses/ Ponies stabled within 15 miles of the showground. Starting height 2' 6".
5	Intermediate Jumping -- Starting height 2' 9"
6	Open Jumping -- Starting height 3' 0"

RING TWO. Jumping in the rubber arena.

Commencing at 8:30 a.m. Sharp - 2:00 p.m.

Entry Fee - £3.00 Payable at the Ring

Prizes: - Rosette on clear round completion.

Class	Event
7	Clear Round Jumping. Jumps will be varying in height throughout the day starting at 1' 6".
Commencing no earlier than 2:30 p.m.	
Entry Fee - £8.00 Prizes: - Trophy and Rosettes	
8	Beginners Jumping. May be accompanied by a non-rider but not led. Max height in first round 1' 6". Horses Ponies and Riders are not eligible to enter any other jumping classes in Ring One. No Spurs permitted.
9	Minor Novice Jumping. Horse, Pony and Rider combination not to have won more than £6.00 in any jumping competition. Max height in first round 2' 0". No Spurs permitted.

RING THREE

Commencing 9:00 a.m. Sharp

Entry Fee - £8.00

Prizes: Trophy & Rosettes.

Class	Event
10	Working Hunter Pony. 14.2hh and under. Jumps 2' 3".
11	Working Hunter Horse. Horses over 14.2hh. Jumps 2' 6" - 2' 9"
12	Riding Ponies. Ponies 14.2hh and under. Not required to jump.
13	Riding Horse. Horses over 14.2hh. Not required to jump.
Commencing no earlier than 1:00 p.m.	
14	Ridden Fancy Dress. Hard hats must be worn.
15	Leading Rein. Ponies not exceeding 12.2hh. Riders 8 years and under. If entering this event the rider cannot then enter an event off the lead rein. Judged 50% Rider and 50% Pony.
16	First Ridden Pony. 13hh and under. Riders 12 years and under. To be judged on manners and suitability for a child just off leading rein.
17	Best Rider. Riders 12 years old and under.
18	Best Rider. Riders 13 years old and over.

Ridden (will not commence before 2:30 p.m.)	
24	Ridden Cob.
25	Ridden Mountain and Moorland inc. Welsh. Registered/Unregistered Judged in 2 sections large/small
26	Ridden Coloured Horse or Pony.
27	Veteran Horse or Pony. 18 years and over.
28	Family Horse or Pony. Suitable to carry adult or child. Will not be required to jump. Judged 40% manners, 30% for type and conformity, 30% versatility.
